



## The 2007 South Carolina Web Accessibility Conference

### Instructions for Conference Attendees

#### *Items to bring with you*

- Notepad
- Pen / Pencil (Your Choice)
- The facility has Wi-Fi so feel free to bring your compatible devices.
- **Bring your business cards!** You will need them to register for door prizes and you may also want to share them with all your new friends. If you do not have a business card, blank cards will be available to fill out.

#### *Parking*

Unfortunately, the new parking garage for the Convention Center is still under construction, which makes parking for the event a slight challenge for us again this year. The small lot next to the Columbia Metropolitan Convention Center will be used by the nearly 700 attending the Assistive Technology Expo. **Please do not park in this lot.** Many of the attendees of the Expo have disabilities and will need these spaces.

Your parking options are as follows:

- SCDOT Auxiliary Parking Lot located on Greene Street between Park Street and Lincoln. It is directly behind the Carolina Coliseum and in front of the Colonial Center. **Spaces here are limited to first come first served.** You will be two blocks away from the Convention Center.
- Overflow lot located on Devine between Lincoln and Huger streets next to the rail road tracks. A shuttle will be provided to the Convention Center from this lot.
- Parking lot located at the Capital City Baseball Stadium on Assembly Street. Shuttle service is provided from this lot as well.

**NOTE: If you have others coming from your office, carpooling would be a great idea. Also, if you work in the surrounding area, consider walking or having someone from your office drop you off.**

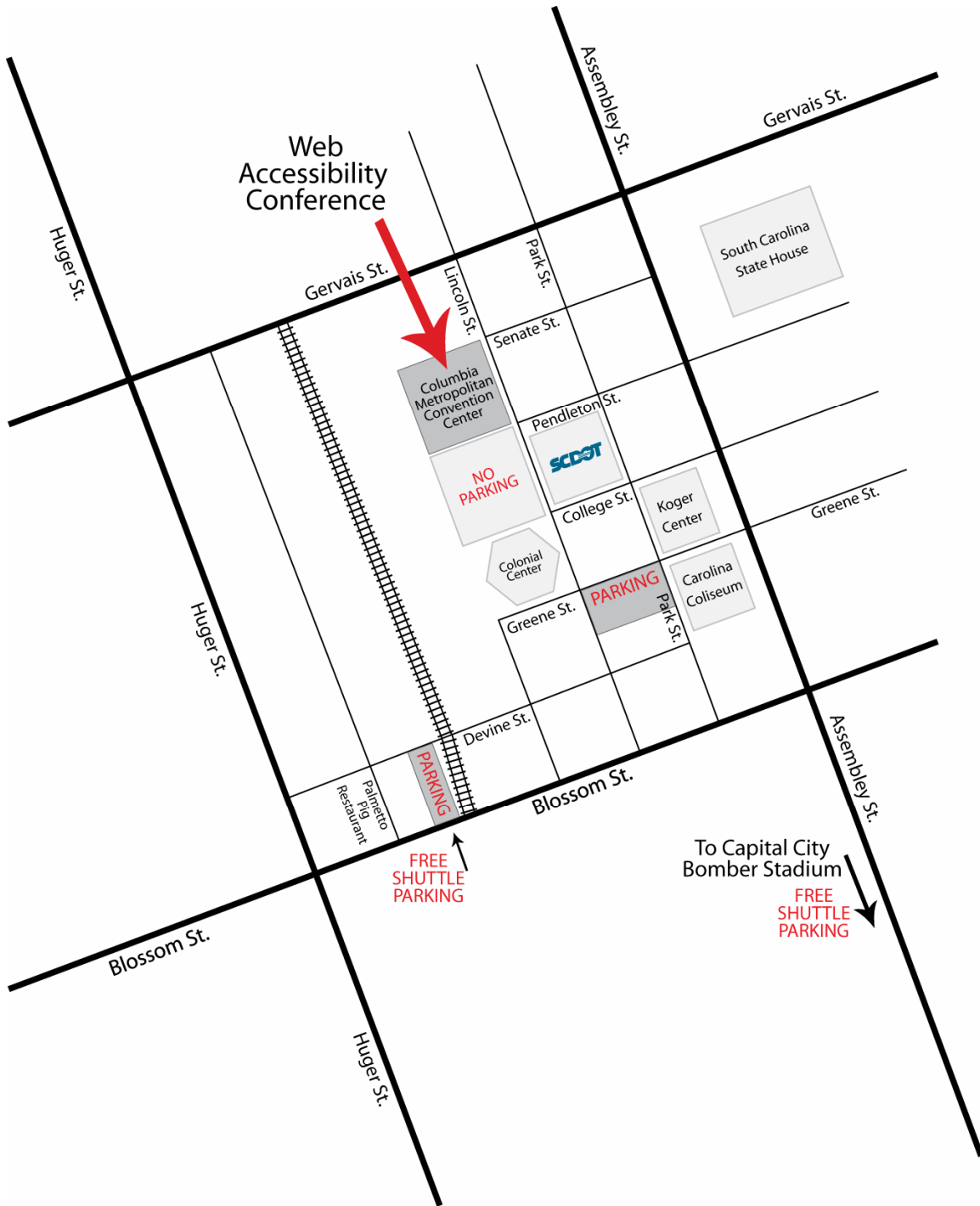
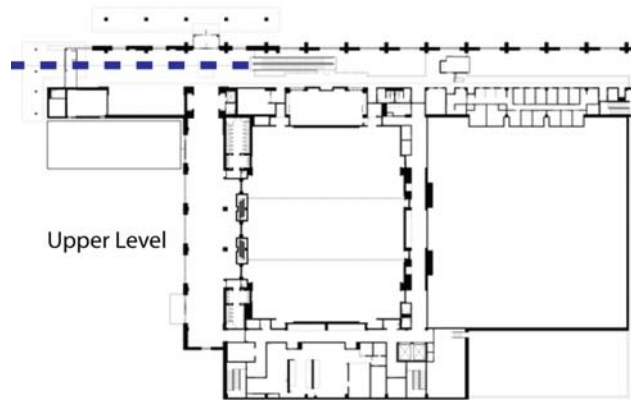


Figure 1 Parking Map

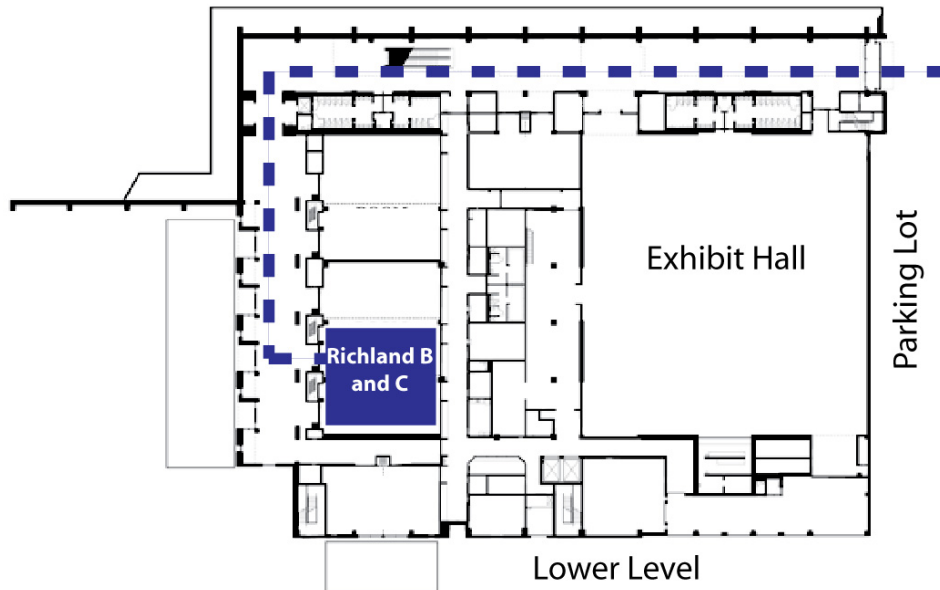
## ***Where to go once you arrive***
